

FROM THE BOARD...

Summer is arriving soon and we hope you are all enjoying the return of some sun. It has been an interesting and challenging water year for many reasons and your OHWA Board of Directors wanted to update you on several things that are in the works. As we head into the warmer months of summer, it is important to keep water conservation tips in mind. Lawns typically need only 1 to 1.5 inches of water per week and water your lawn in the morning or evening to cut down on evaporation.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The Board of Directors has been working to move forward on adopting a new cartridge filtration system at the water treatment plant that would more reliably allow us to use our spring well during the times of the year when water demand is higher. The cartridge filtration system has been installed and will be online for the summer months making us less dependent on the connection with the City of Salem.
